Pioneers of Photography in the City of Worcester & Around by Ray Jones BA. comprises more than 330 photographs which date from the early 1860s upto the Second World War. These are spread over 160 pages (A4 size) in a hardbound book accompanied by interesting and little known facts about Worcester's pioneering photographers. Photographic subjects represented include rare back street views; early aviation; railway, tram and flood scenes; coronation celebrations and the 1908 election campaign; local events and unusual social history. The highlight of this book is the publication of three previously unknown photographs of suffragettes campaigning in Worcester. Photographic trips into the rural areas - such as Kempsey, Hallow, and the Teme valley are also fully covered.

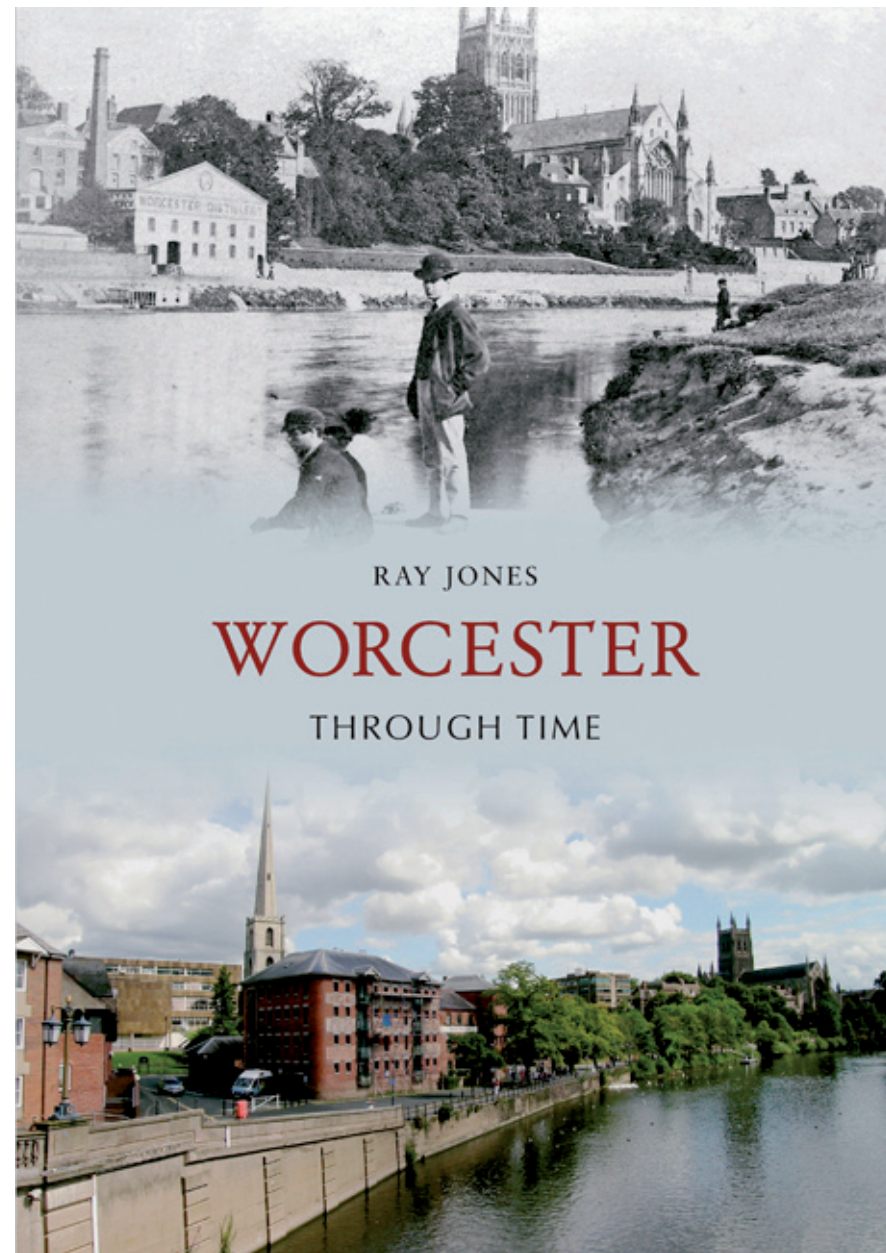

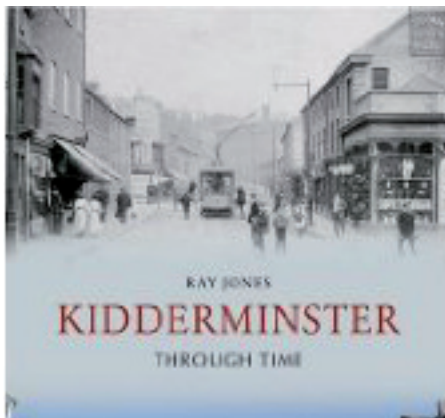
This work comprises more than 180 photographs (old in black and white, modern in colour). These are spread over 96 pages and published by Amberley Books.
